Objective. A Member at Large typically represents the general membership on issues of interest or concern, particularly those that arise outside the standing committee structure.

The Member at Large conducts projects to further the goals of the club or to develop services for the membership.

The Member at Large could serve as chair of any ad hoc committee formed to develop a project.

The Member at Large listens to membership and communicates issues, needs and interests to the Board of Directors.

The Member at Large works toward common goals as a team member.

The Member at Large sets objectives and develops action plans for selected or assigned projects and special projects.

The Member at Large can be considered as a membership representative, can be a committee head, and can be assigned geographic criteria.

The Member at Large is a valued Board Member.
